## **Green Hope High School Falcon Athletic Booster Club Scholarship**

The Green Hope High School Falcon Athletic Booster Club will award scholarships to two senior athletes who have demonstrated outstanding leadership academically, athletically and within their community. There will be two scholarships awarded at \$1,000 each, one for a female GHHS student and one for a male GHHS student. This year, our Fight for 55 sponsor, Chick-fil-A, will be funding the scholarships.

To be eligible for nomination, a student must be a senior at Green Hope High School, a member of the Green Hope High School Falcon Athletic Booster Club, and meet the following minimum requirements: (1) Un-weighted GPA of 2.5, (2) Participated in the Green Hope High School athletics program (Athletes, Managers, and Trainers), (3) Plan to attend a college, university, community college or technical school, (4) Demonstrated support of the Falcon Athletic Booster Club as a student of

GHHS, (5) Is not receiving any other NCAA Athletic Financial Funding per NCAA guidelines.

### **Green Hope High School Fine Arts Boosters Scholarship**

The Green Hope High School Fine Arts Boosters organization (FAB) wishes to present two GHHS college-bound seniors with \$1,000 scholarships. The purpose of this award is to recognize graduates who have been active in the programs supported by FAB—Chorus, Dance, Drama, Technical Theatre, Guitar, Orchestra, and Visual Art--while demonstrating good character, leadership qualities, and scholarship during their tenures at GHHS.

Applicants will be evaluated by a committee comprised of three adults familiar with the arts.

Note: The recipients of the Mistletoe Market scholarship are not eligible for the Green Hope High School Fine Arts Booster Scholarship.

To meet the criteria established for this scholarship, candidates must have: (1) received a letter of acceptance from a vocational school, community college, or 4-year college or university (2) maintained a "B" or 3.0 weighted grade point average.

**The Knightdale – Wake Forest Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. – The Crowns at High Noon Seasons of Life Scholarship**

The Knightdale-Wake Forest Alumnae Chapter will award a \$1,000 scholarship to a deserving, African-American student that has demonstrated exceptional academic and leadership skills. Applicants must meet the following criteria: The candidate must be a current, African-American high school senior, entering as a freshman in Fall 2017 at an accredited college/university with at least a 3.0 or equivalent unweighted grade point average (GPA). Students must have an overall 3.0 GPA and must have maintained at least a 3.0 GPA throughout his/her senior year of high school. Candidate must attend a high school in Wake County.

**Raleigh Jaycees Scholarship**

Since 2003, the Raleigh Jaycees have awarded scholarships to Wake County students who have demonstrated leadership through community service.

This year, this organization will be awarding \$1,000 to a student who enrolls at a four-year college or university and \$1,000 to a student who enrolls at a technical or community college.

Other eligibility criteria include graduation from a Wake County high school in 2017; maintenance of a B or better average; participation and leadership in community service activities; and recommendation by an administrator, counselor, teacher, employer, or community service supervisor.

**The Raleigh Mayor's Committee for Persons with Disabilities Scholarship**

This organization will award two scholarships for \$1,000 each to assist persons with documented disabilities in their pursuit of academic and vocational endeavors. The academic scholarship is to be awarded to a person with a disability who is pursuing an educational goal. This

scholarship is designed to assist with tuition, books, fees, and/or special equipment for undergraduate course work from an accredited institution.

The vocational scholarship is to assist an individual with a disability to pursue a vocational education. This money may be applied to the purchase of items such as tools, special equipment or tuition and fees to enhance and sustain employment opportunities.

Applicants must be residents of the city of Raleigh and must be enrolled in or have been accepted to an accredited undergraduate post-secondary school, college, trade school or other institution of higher learning. The selection of scholarship recipients shall be based upon academic performance, financial need, character, school, work and community activities, honors, ability to express him/herself in written form, personal motivation and/or leadership potential.

The scholarship application is available in Student Services, and the deadline is **May 31, 2017**. Scholarship recipients will be recognized at the July Raleigh Mayor's Committee meeting.

### **North State Law Enforcement Officers Association Educational Scholarship**

This organization is awarding one scholarship of \$1,000 and two scholarships of \$500. Criteria include: (1) Must be a resident of North Carolina, (2) Grade point average must be 3.0 or better, (3) Intend to major in some area of Criminal Justice or related field, (4) Must supply a copy of the FAFSA, and the student need criteria number will be considered, (5) The number of siblings in the family (and if any are currently attending college) will be considered, (6) Student must be active in the community, church and/or school activities, and (7) The student must have no felony convictions or convictions of serious misdemeanors, and may not have any pending criminal matters.
