## New AP Exam Registration Information and Deadlines for Students Enrolled in First Semester and Year-Long AP Classes

The CollegeBoard AP Program is making some changes to the way students register for AP Exams taken in May.

All AP students will log into their CollegeBoard accounts to register for their exams and to access material for their AP courses. Perhaps the biggest change will involve students registering for their exams in the fall for 1<sup>st</sup> semester and year-long AP courses. Please follow these directions to set up or retrieve your account with CollegeBoard and access registration and course material for your 1<sup>st</sup> semester and year-long AP courses:

### Action Items for Students:

- Go to [myap.collegeboard.org](http://myap.collegeboard.org).
  - o If you already have established a CollegeBoard account, make certain that you can log in.
  - o If you have forgotten your password, you may call 888-225- 5427 or email [apstudents@info.collegeboard.org](mailto:apstudents@info.collegeboard.org) for help.
- AP teachers will provide students with a join code specific to their class and period.
- Students will follow prompts in CollegeBoard account to join courses.
- Once a student has joined a course, students will need to indicate whether or not they will be taking the AP Exam for each class they join by **October 18, 2019**.

Joining a class will allow students access to a set of new resources designed to provide them with practice opportunities and feedback throughout the year. **Students in AP courses in the spring will repeat this process at the beginning of 2<sup>nd</sup> semester.**

### Fees

What is the cost for AP exams?

- **\$0** for students enrolled in the AP course during the 2019-2020 school year.
- **\$94** for Self-Study students (students not enrolled in the AP course during the 2019-2020 school year).

What are the other fees associated with AP exams?

- Each of the following will incur an additional **\$40** fee per exam:
  - o Students in 1<sup>st</sup> Semester or Year-Long AP classes, Self-Study students and Home-School students who order AP exams between November 16, 2019 and March 13, 2020.
  - o Exams canceled after November 15, 2019 and by March 13, 2020.
  - o Unused exam (exam ordered but the student did not sit for the exam in May).

### Additional Information

- Testing Accommodations
  - o If you need to request testing accommodations, you must apply to the CollegeBoard directly. Applications take about 6 – 8 weeks to process.
  - o Accommodations determined by the school do not apply to CollegeBoard tests.
  - o The deadline to apply for accommodations is **January 17, 2020**. If students have additional questions about CollegeBoard accommodations, please contact Jessica Merry, [jmerry@wcpss.net](mailto:jmerry@wcpss.net).
- Exam Schedule Conflicts
  - o If a student has two exams at the same time, one of the exams will be taken in a late testing session. Students will receive notice from Mr. McIntyre about the test, time, and location closer to the exam administration.
